RESTAURANTS AND HOTELS ARE AT RISK OF PERMANENT CLOSURE IF RESTRICTIONS DON'T CHANGE



THERE ARE STILL **200,000** FEWER RESTAURANT AND HOTEL EMPLOYEES WORKING THAN THERE WERE IN FEBRUARY, WITH MANY MORE JOBS AT RISK AS COLDER WEATHER APPROACHES

74% OF RESTAURANT OPERATORS DON'T EXPECT SALES TO RETURN TO PRE-PANDEMIC LEVELS WITHIN 6 MONTHS



2 OUT OF 3 HOTELS REMAIN BELOW 50% OCCUPANCY

62% OF RESTAURANT OPERATORS REPORT HIGHER OPERATING COSTS SINCE THE ONSET OF THE PANDEMIC
